



## Youth Trip Behavior Covenant

These are the ground rules for our upcoming trip together. If they are unclear or unreasonable, please talk to Jake Fry before you leave for the trip.

- ✓ I will keep an open mind and find ways to enjoy each moment of the trip.
- ✓ No drugs, alcohol, tobacco (smoke or chew), pot, gambling, or fireworks.
- ✓ I will be hospitable to strangers and not exclude others in my own group.
- ✓ I will be responsible for being on time for all departures and scheduled activities during the trip. I will be in my room/cabin by the designated times determined by our group leader.
- ✓ I will view this event as an opportunity to grow spiritually.
- ✓ At night, there will be assigned space for sleeping for males and females. I will respect this space.
- ✓ I will respect the property of others. If I cause any damage to another's property, it will be my responsibility to replace or repair it.
- ✓ We place a premium on safety and proper supervision. Sneaking out after lights out is prohibited. And pranks (even the most innocent kind) are not allowed.
- ✓ I will refrain from swearing and abusive language.
- ✓ I will be open to being changed and stretched by the Holy Spirit. I will respect the times when we worship and treat the experience as holy ground.
- ✓ I understand that God wants my full attention for this event. I will therefore refrain from sexual activity as well as public and private displays of affection for another person.
- ✓ I understand that the adults will treat me with respect. Yet when we disagree, they have the final authority, and I agree to respect their directions and decisions.
- ✓ I realize that if I break this covenant, the leaders will have the authority to impose consequences, which may involve removal from the trip at my parent's expense and a special meeting with my parents, Jake Fry, and myself upon return.
